## **Description of Agenda Items**

### **School Coaching Project – Chris Wright**

This session will offer an overview of the project. It will include examples of how the programme might be deployed within a CSP area. Some time for questions and solutions will follow.

### **UK Coaching Framework – Pete Ezard**

This session will focus on the UK Coaching Framework, which was launched nationally in May 08. It will then look at the Region and address the delivery of headline areas in the Framework across our 5 counties. A key ambition is to help sports develop their own 'East Midlands' picture. This will be based on the participant and coach models being developed by each of their NGB national offices. A Regional Strategy Group, involving key partners, has recently been set up to support the implementation of all this. The NGB Forum is represented on this group.

### **Skills Active – Jeff Spencer**

This session involves a powerpoint presentation and discussion on the people development element of upcoming NGB plans. It will include an opportunity for questions and answers. Outcomes are as follows:

- An understanding of what the 'people development' needs of an NGB might be
- Develop awareness of current areas of support available and who to contact
- Start to formulate how sports will plan to link with the support available

### **Development of Engagement Project – David Joy**

As a result of the recent report produced by consultants (posted on the East Mids NGB Forum web pages) the 5 CSP Directors met to consider how they can offer support to NGBs in a more uniform way. David Joy, Director of Derbyshire Sport, will report on the CSP Directors' discussions. There will also be an update of what is being actioned as a result of this meeting.

A short interactive session, to confirm the areas of support being offered, will also be included in this part of the meeting.

### **Joint CSP Presentation**

The 5 CSPs will give an overview of the Extended Activities plans being finalised in their counties. Each will also focus on one other key issue for NGBs at the moment. There will be an opportunity for questions and answers.
