3rd Sector Volunteering Project

In conjunction with 3rd Sector Partners and the CSPs, JP has been consulting about a project that will help broker links between Volunteer Centres and sports clubs. This will help find volunteers for clubs & voluntary sports organisations, ensuring that these volunteers are offered a positive placement. This session aims to highlight the key elements of the project and consult with NGBs about the outcomes that would most help them. The plan is to apply for funding to make this project work.

Future of the NGB Forum

As a result of the new 09-13 plans, the delivery infrastructure within many NGBs is changing. Additionally, the Forum Development Officer's project is entering the last 6 months of delivery. So now seems to be an appropriate time to think about the future of the Regional NGB Forum. This session aims only to highlight the issues. NGBs will be requested to note these and consider them in the light of their sport's intended delivery. A full debate on the future role of the Forum will be held at the December meeting.

Coaching Update

Sports Coach UK is finalising the introduction of Coaching Managers in CSPs. Additionally the Coach CPD Pilot, being negotiated in the East Midlands, is reaching some conclusions. Find out more about these projects and their implementation.

NGB / CSP Engagement

This session concerns the new engagement process between NGBs and CSPs. Whilst some may consider that 09-13 plans are ready for implementation, NGBs nationally are at different stages of readiness for engaging with CSPs. This will have a knock on effect at a more local level. So what is the process and how will this work?

This session will outline the core priorities for NGBs and explain how these are being broken down to 'targeted' local delivery. It will also detail how CSPs are aligning themselves to support this. Finally, through a question and answer session, it should enable NGB Officers to know what information to request internally, if intelligence is filtering down slowly within their sport.

The key deliverers of this session will be Nigel Holl the National Development Manger for England Netball and David Joy the Director of Derbyshire Sport.
