

Main Tasks for Role of the CSP Coaching Development Manager (Draft 24)

The Coaching Development Managers will be part of a national Coaching Support Network team who will be inducted, trained and supported role by sports coach UK, whilst being line managed by the CSP. Support from sportscoachuk will include regular liaison relating to key functions and targeted professional development opportunities.

Main Purpose of the Role: To manage the development of a local coaching support network within Nottinghamshire in response to the requirements of local, regional and national partners

Proposed Key Tasks

- Work in partnership with sportscoachUK to develop and implement a 4 year Coaching Strategy with quarterly reviewed milestones for County Coaching Support Network area, in line with the requirements of NGBs and in the current context of the UK Coaching Framework
- Manage the development of a local Coaching Support Network to support coaches at community level in response to Governing Body Whole Sport Plans. This work to occur as part of a nationally co-ordinated network and in line with the UK Coaching Framework
- Manage the recruitment of active and qualified, local coaches and support them to register on-line with the CSP utilising and / or linking with the agreed National Data Management System
- Provide NGBs and their coaches with a mechanism by which they can receive local support to help facilitate the deployment of their paid / voluntary coaches in a range of settings including schools, local authority and national programmes (Community Sports Coach Scheme; School Sports Coaching Programme; Recruit into Coaching; Sport Unlimited)
- Embed nationally endorsed Minimum Standards for Deployment in coaching within the Coaching Support Network, particularly within school, local authority and national programme settings
- Support the development of a local workforce that facilitates the production and implementation of Personal Development Plans for coaches
- Support and extend a network of coach education and learning providers to ensure that there is effective and efficient provision of "learner centred" coach education and professional development opportunities
- Support the Coaching Support Network with investigating and securing sources of additional funding for coaching. In particular working in partnership with the NSA to promote, implement and review of the SkillsActive Bursary Scheme at a local level based on identified NGB needs.
- Manage a data management system in line with national recommendations that has the capacity to record contact and qualification details, and acts as a tool to support CPD requirements. Provide monthly, quarterly and annual reports for appropriate local/national agencies, measuring performance against targets
- Establish a local coaching communication network that provides coaches with access to education, development and employment opportunities, and examples of good practice
- Embed nationally determined Research Programmes into the Coaching Support Network that are established to investigate the impact of coaching on Grow, Sustain and Excel
